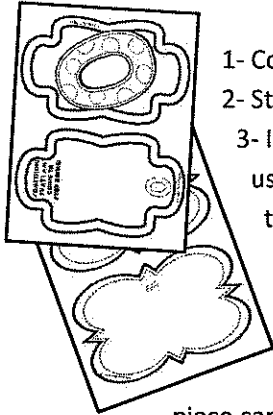


2022 New Year's Resolution & Goal Setting Mobile

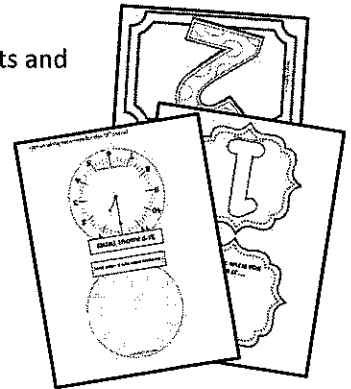
Teacher Directions

This resource includes everything you need to get your students reflecting over the past year and ready for the new one!



Directions for Use:

- 1- Copy a set of mobile pieces for each student. Regular copy paper will work just fine.
- 2- Staple each set together. This will prevent pages from getting lost.
- 3- Instruct students to complete each piece of the mobile. I always encourage students to use lots of colors and do their best work. I remind them that these mobiles will be visible to everyone in the school (I usually hang mine in the hallways) and that their name is on their work.
- 4- Once students have completed the different mini-assignments and have colored each piece (I tell my students to NOT color over their writing as it makes it hard to read), they cut around each piece carefully, leaving the black edge.
- 5- Give each student approximately 36 inches of string. Have them lay the first piece (New Year, New Me!) face down on their desk and use a glue stick to glue the name side to it.
- 6- Continue laying the numbers (BE SURE THEY ARE IN THE CORRECT ORDER, SO THE CURRENT YEAR IS VISIBLE) face down and gluing their assignment side with a glue stick.
- 7- Hang/display them for the class/school to enjoy once they are glued together.
- 8- Download the updated file and repeat next year. :0)



Alternate ways to enjoy your New Year's Mobile:

- Send home the set and ask the student to bring back the pieces colored and completed. Then do the construction of the mobile during class time.
- Ask students to share ONE (or more) of their mobile pieces with the class or in small groups. By allowing them to choose, they are more likely to share.
- Brainstorm "good" goals, etc., with your students BEFORE starting the project.
- Glue it into a notebook/on construction paper with the written part UNDER the number. Only glue the top edge of the number allowing it to become a flap that lifts!

I hope you enjoy sharing this New Year's activity with your students as much as I enjoyed creating it for my class!

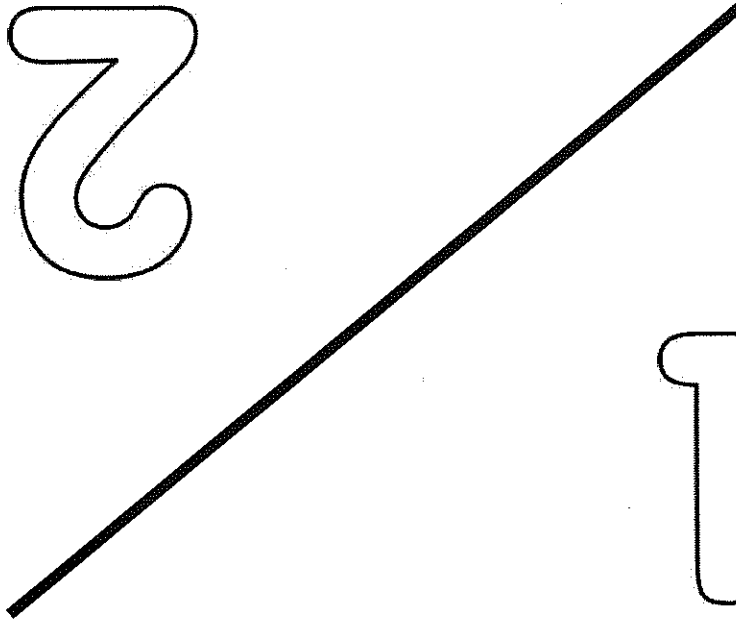

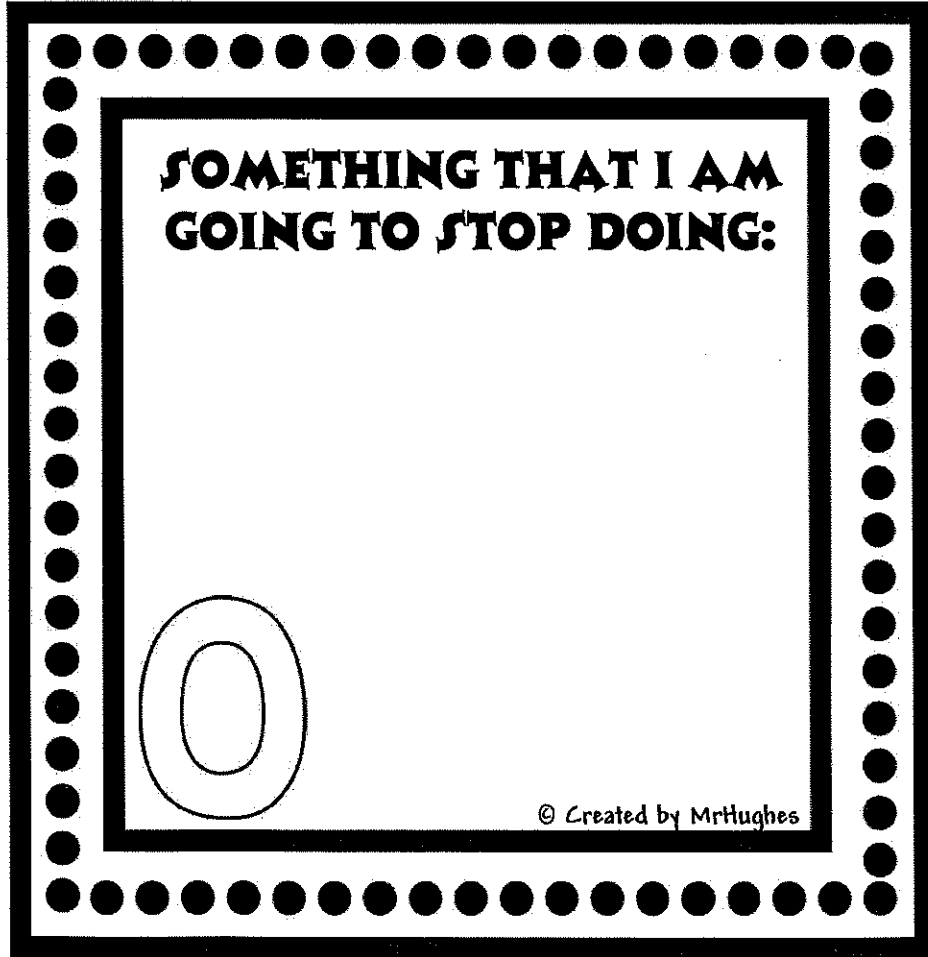
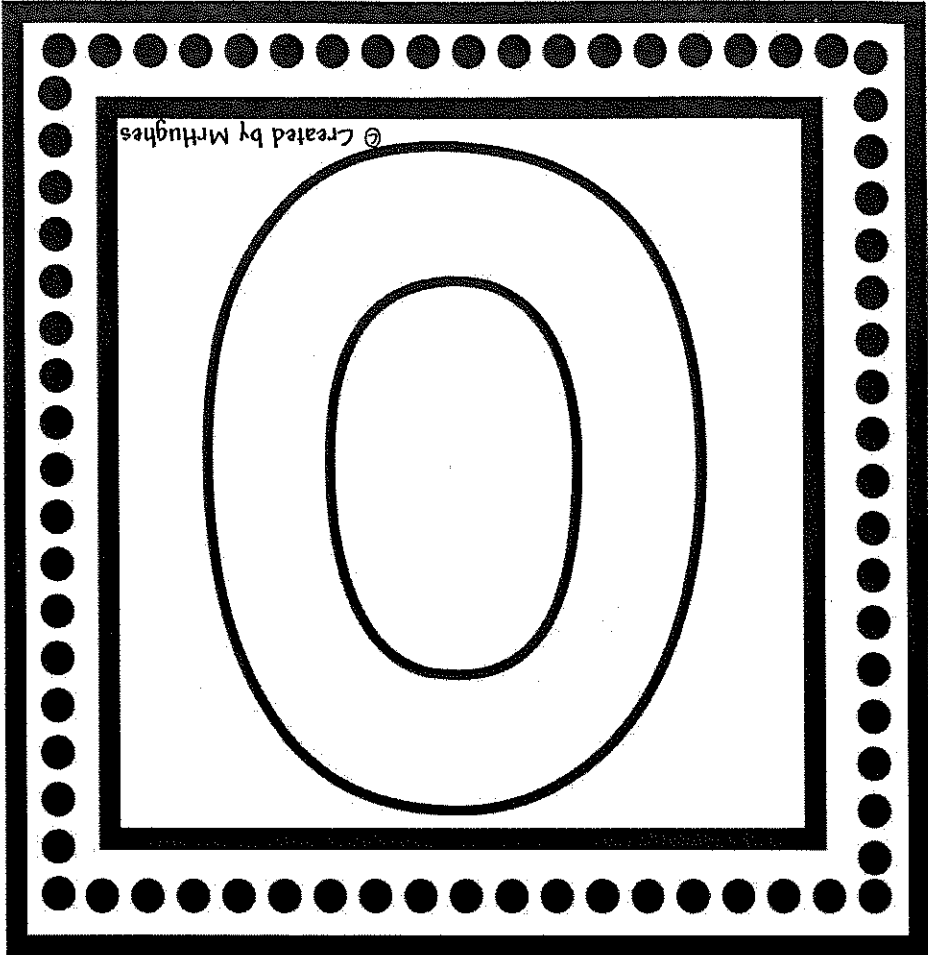
