"Proud to be PRIMARY"

NOTE: Your students will have the most success if you model and give them plenty of time to complete each step.

1. Place a large white piece of art paper in portrait orientation. Starting in the middle of the page draw a large circle for the head.
2. Draw two curved lines from the head to the bottom of the page. Draw a curved line under the head to draw a scarf. Add a few scarf pieces. Add a pattern to the scarf.
3. Draw 3 circles for buttons under the scarf.
4. Draw a triangle in the center of the face on an angle to look like a carrot nose.
5. Add small circles in the shape of a smile under the carrot nose.
6. Add two circles for eyes above the nose.

7. Draw an oval on its side on the top of the head.

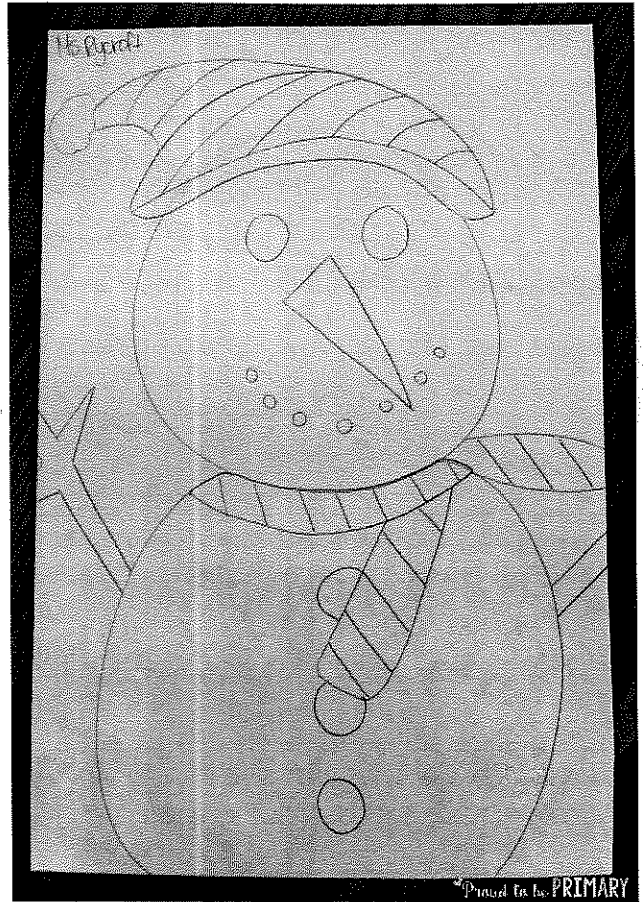
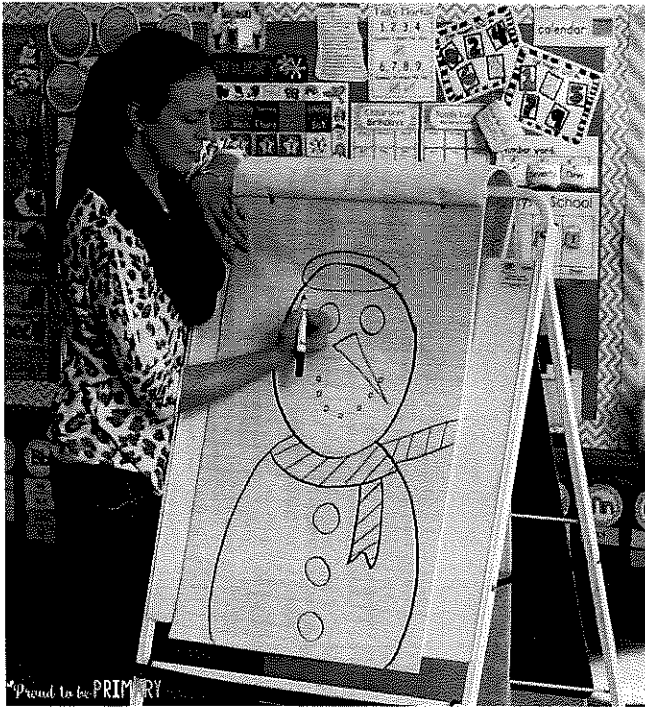
Erase the line inside the oval. Add a triangle shape on top of the oval and a pom pom on top. Add a pattern to the hat.

8. Since there will likely not be much room around the snowman, explain that the arms will shoot off the page like you are looking close-up to the snowman. Draw two parallel lines going off the page in an upward direction on each side. Draw a hand if there is space with 3 pointed ends.

9. Use a fine point black marker or Sharpie pen to trace all the lines of your winter friend. Erase the pencil lines with a good white eraser.

10. Use watercolour paints to paint the background behind the snowman in a bright colour. Paint all the snowman details only (the hat, eyes, nose, mouth, scarf, arms).but leave the body white.
